

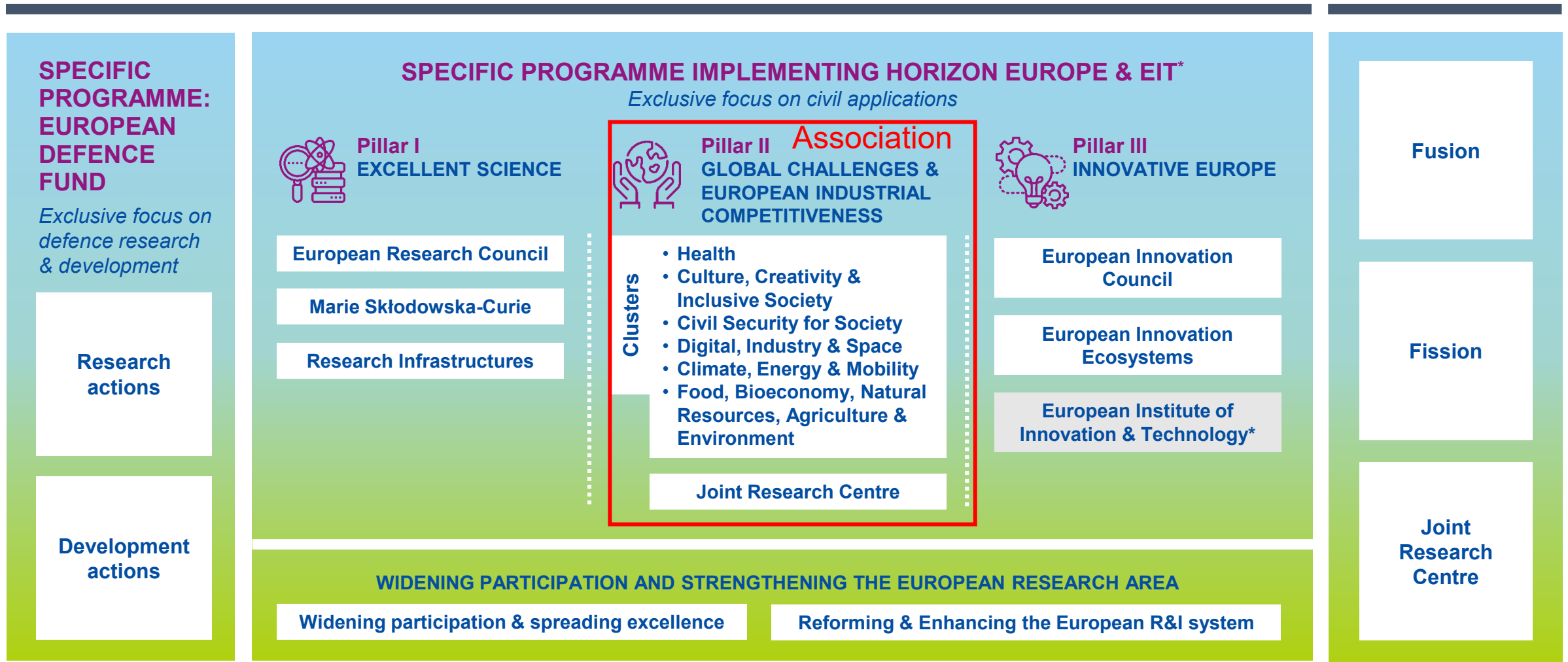
National Contact Points are the main structure to provide information, guidance and assistance on participation in Horizon Europe.

Participation to Horizon Europe

- Minimum Condition: Consortium of 3 independent entities from three different EU Member States /Associated countries.
 - EU Member States (27 Member States)
 - Associated Countries : New commers incl. Ukraine, United Kingdom, New Zealand, Canada, South Korea, Switzerland, Egypt... Japan is joining soon.
- All legal entities based in Japan (academic, public org, industry incl. start-ups)
 - Can Participate/coordinate and receive automatic funds in Pillar2 (2026- 2027)
 - Can participate as partners in all pillars without funds (2021-2027)

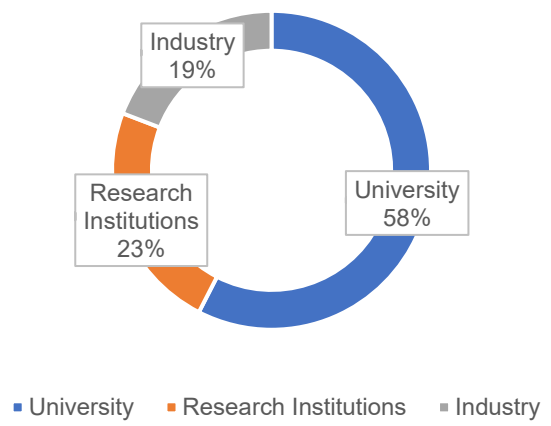

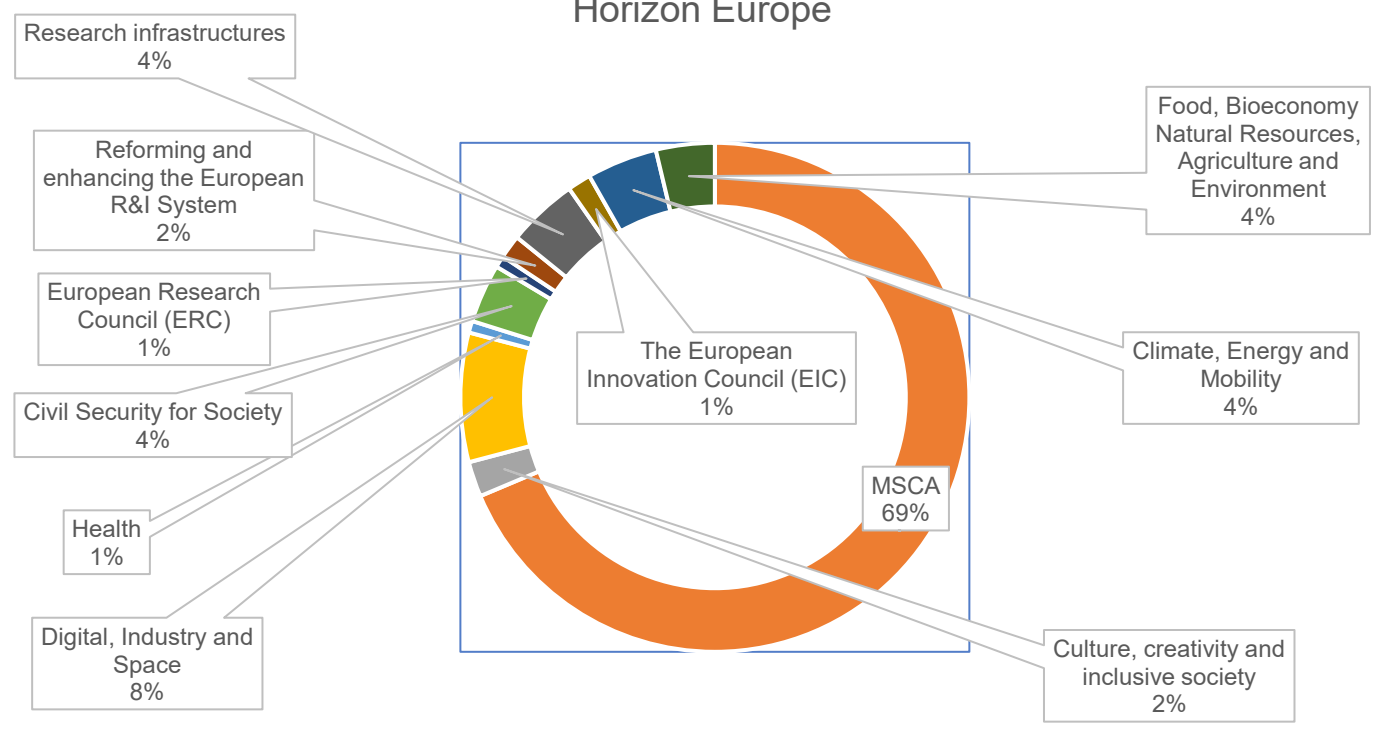
